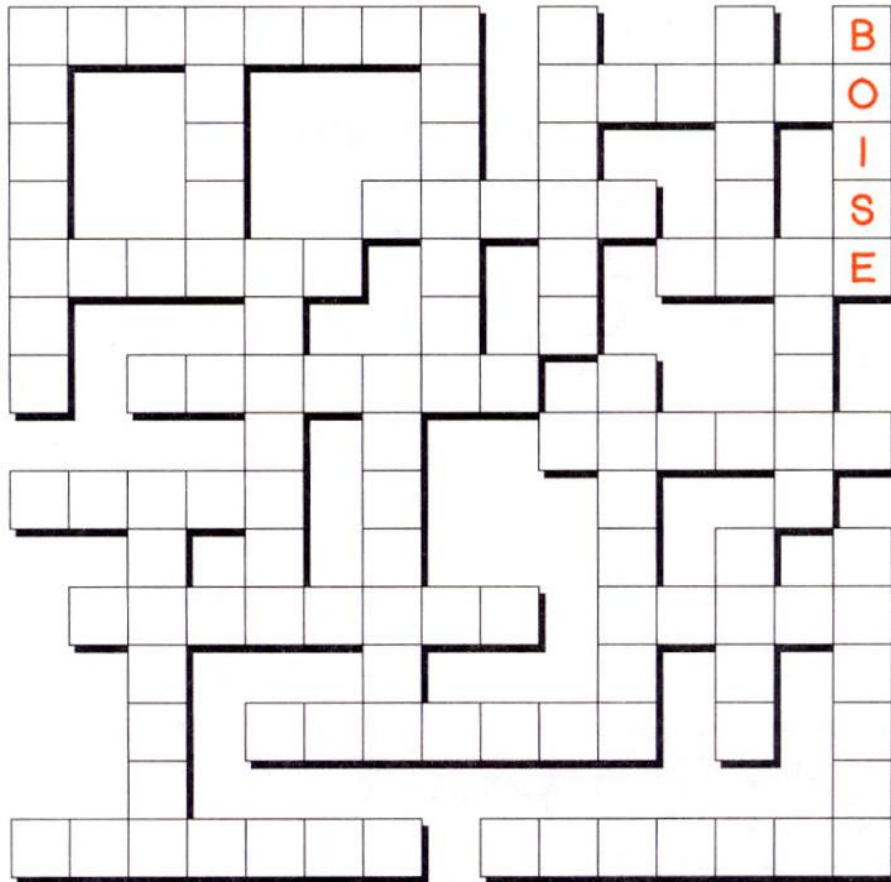


CITY-CROSS
