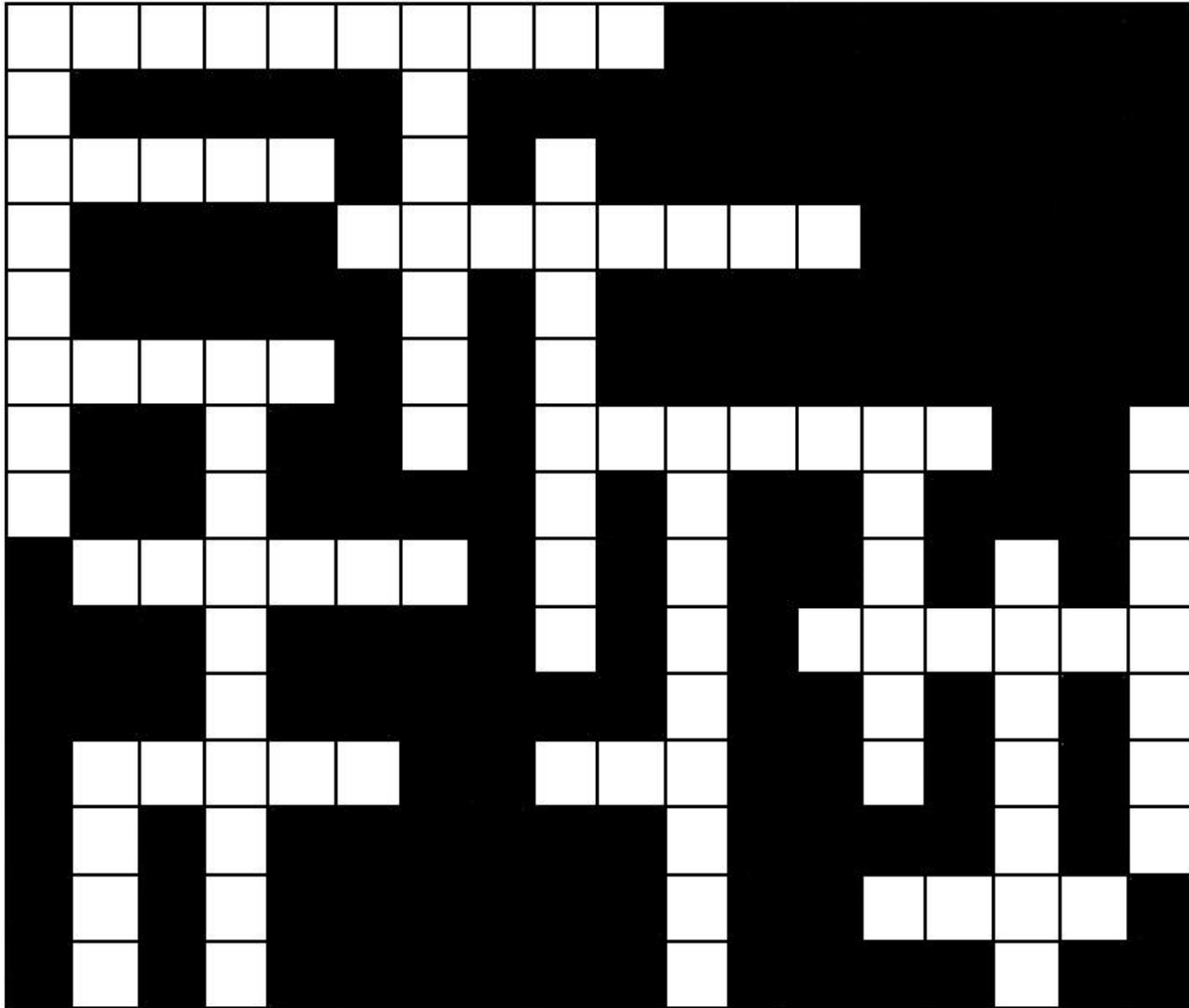


Cross Proverbs
