
Cross Proverbs

Cross Proverbs is similar to a Cross Word Puzzle but words are inserted into the squares instead of letters. Hidden in the 20 x 15 grid below are 22 well-known proverbs, 11 vertically and 11 horizontally. The only clues that you are given are "key phrases" from each of the maxims.



Key Phrases:

- "best policy" "better than one" "bird in the hand" "early to rise" "friend in need" "gift horse" "greener on the other side" "is bliss"
- "is golden" "is power" "judge a book" "like the present" "little knowledge" "mice will play" "move mountains"
- "nothing is certain" "penny saved" "slow and steady" "the bigger" "there's a will" "thicker than water" "where the heart is"
